It is **against the law** to make **alcohol** available to any other person **younger than 21**. This law **applies to everyone** that provides alcohol to a minor, **even** if the provider is **under 21**. Law enforcement agents **will** attempt to **determine the source** of the alcohol when minors are found to be in possession.

(In Texas, a person may provide alcohol to a minor if he or she is the minor's adult parent, guardian, or spouse, and is visibly present when the minor possesses or consumes the alcoholic beverage.)

***If you break the law, you could receive up to:***

***One year in jail and/or a \$4,000 fine***

**AND**

***An automatic suspension of your driver's license for 180 days upon conviction.***

**PLUS**

***You could be held civilly liable for damages caused by a person younger than 18 if you provided them alcohol or allowed them to be given alcohol while on your property.***
